## Electronic Interference Reports Made to UKMTO



- The heat-mapping above indicates the relative levels of electronic interference in the form of AIS anomalies during the period 04 September to 11 September. In the Red Sea, electronic interference has apparently increased slightly compared to last week, with a higher concentration around the ports of Yanbu, Jeddah and Sudan. Within the Gulf, electronic interference in the form of AIS anomalies levels continues, notably around Jebel Ali, Fujairah and the Strait of Hormuz.
- Whilst UKMTO has received a number of direct reports of GPS interference in this period, with specific GPS interference being reported as indicated by the turquoise spot reports in the Red Sea and Strait of Hormuz; UKMTO has also had contrary direct reports from other vessels, evidently experiencing no electronic interference whatsoever. Two other vessels reported experiencing GPS interference only within the Strait of Hormuz, whilst another two vessels reported only having experienced GPS interference within the Red Sea.
- **Note:** *The apparently contrary reporting may be a constraint of (1) Snapshots within a relatively short period time of exposure; and/or (2) A reduced-data set during this reporting period. All Vessels are requested to report any experience of electronic interference to UKMTO, in support of keeping the broader community more accurately informed.*
