## **Electronic Interference Reports Made to UKMTO**

# Date Range 10 - 17 December 2025



- The highest levels of concentration (Amber critical) observed is around Dubai, followed by moderate levels seen around Abu Dhabi, Fujairah Anchorage, Port of Jeddah and Central Red Sea
- Severe levels are observed in the vicinity of Port Sudan, slightly lower than last week, but still classed within higher level range. The lowest levels observed were seen at the end of the corridors entering the Arabian Gulf after Strait of Hormuz,, and in the Northern Red Sea.
- There is still a noticeable lack of compliance from direct reporting for vessels experiencing such event.

#### For reference:

- HexBin colours Red (>100) = Critical, Amber (100->50) = Severe, Yellow (50->25) = Moderate and Green (25->5) = Low, <5 is discounted.</li>
- There has been a slight change in methodology of AIS Speed Anomalies extraction, which allows all anomalous tracks to be extracted, the positions are then filtered to exclude those on land so anomalous positions are contained within sea areas.
- All Vessels are requested to report any experience of electronic interference to UKMTO, in support of keeping the broader community more accurately informed.
