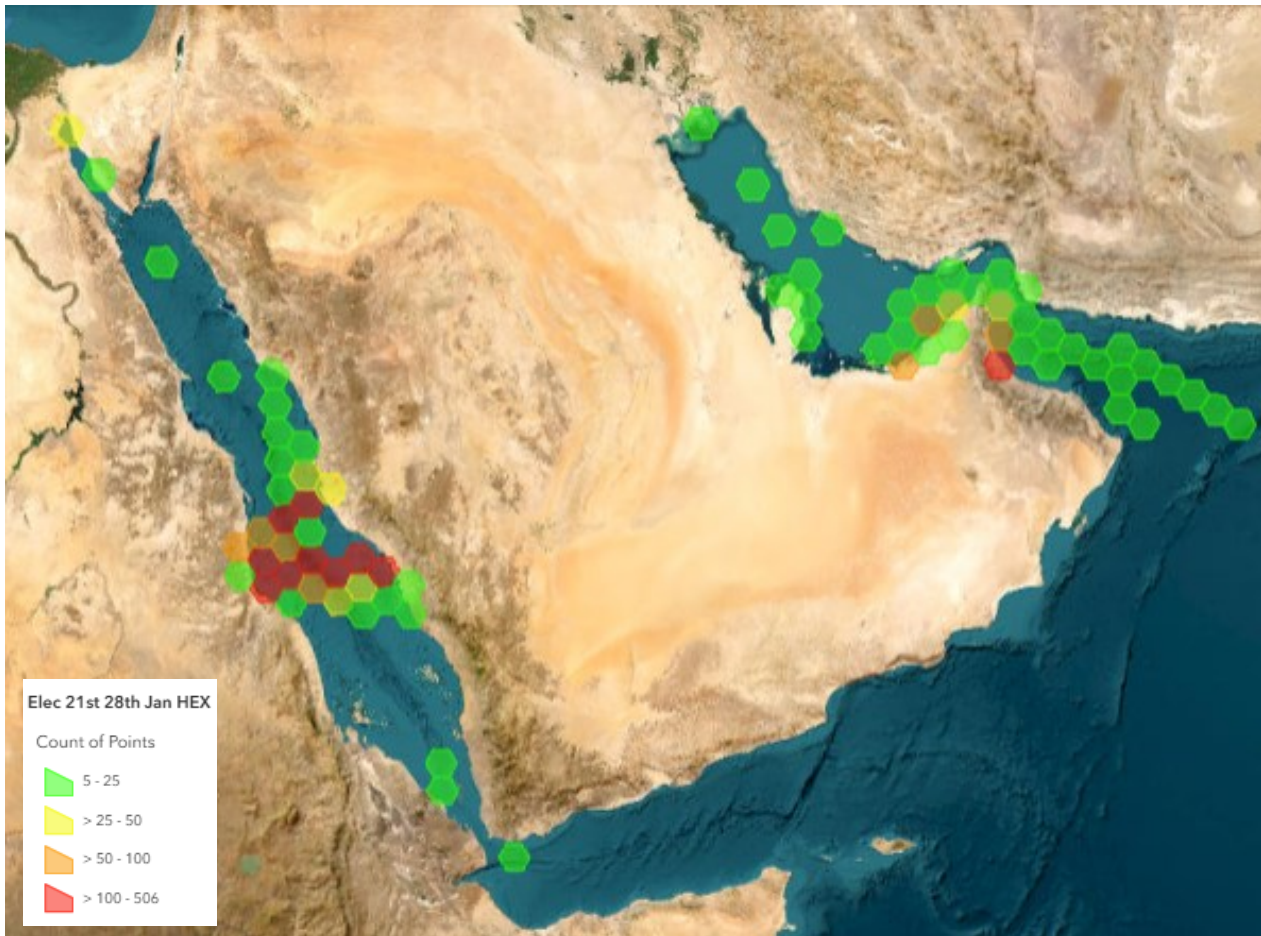

## Electronic Interference Reports Made to UKMTO



- Sustained low levels of Electronic Interference have been observed in Gulf of Oman, Arabian Gulf and throughout the Strait of Hormuz.
- The ports of Abu Dhabi, Dubai, and the ports along the coastline from Khor Fakkan to Sohar, Oman, have all seen increased levels of interference, ranging from moderate to critical. However, this is not deemed to have a significant impact on ships navigation or safety.
- In the Central Red Sea region, the highest levels of interference range from Port Sudan across to the western Saudi Arabian coastline, but in general, the Central Red Sea Region levels remain in the range of moderate and above.
- As per the past few weeks, there appears to be a lack of compliance in direct reporting from vessels .
